On June 2, 2020, Renewable World Energies (RWE), on behalf of U.P. Hydro (Licensee) filed a Notice of Intent to Surrender License and Expedited Request for Authorization to Commence Spillway Upgrades at the Au Train project (Project). The cover letter incorrectly stated that "RWE also proposes to cut 18 inches of earth off the top of the embankment on either side of the concrete spillway at North Dam." The design does not incorporate this earth removal and is not contained in the design report attached to that filing.
